## MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, May 15, 2024, 4:00 P.M.

Town Board Special Meeting

7166 County Highway K

1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL, CONFIRMATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETINGS LAW  
The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. at 7166 County Highway K.

Roll call shows Supervisors Dan Dresen, Matt Wright, and Leon Zinck III present.

Also present was property owner Howard Wagner.

2. INSPECTION OF PROPERTY AND OUTBUILDINGS TO DETERMINE COMPLIANCE WITH COURT ORDER

Observations of attendees:

- Lawn is generally overgrown and unkempt. It appears the front lawn was mowed recently although the majority of the lawn area is > 8" in height, significant weed/burdock growth present throughout the property;
- A dead tree is present west of the driveway which overhangs the electric service to the house;
- Two pickup trucks are parked in the driveway in front of the house, a third one near the shed behind the house. One of the trucks had new license plates expiring Dec 2024. All trucks full of detritus and food stuffs. Numerous cats are present in the vehicles;
- Two washing machines are located outside the rear shed along the south door;
- Many other miscellaneous items are present in the area around the outside of the rear shed;
- The interior of the rear shed is full of miscellaneous items, some perishable food items, and generally filthy and approximately 1/2 full. A U-shaped walking path is present within the building which allows access to the majority of the interior space. The floor of the shed is covered with animal feces. The building generally has an extremely foul odor and caused this representative to begin coughing.
- When questioned about the duration of the perishable food present in the truck near the shed, Mr. Wegner replied it has been present since Thursday 5/9/24.

3. ACTION, AS NEEDED, RESULTING FROM INSPECTION RESULTS
